Measles

The Essex Child and Wellbeing Services have asked us to share this advice with you after they have been made aware of a case of measles in the local area. They have asked that you do not contact the hospital directly if you suspect your child has measles but you should;

Ask for a GP appointment/call 111 for support if:

- you suspect your child has measles
- your child is under 1 year old and been in contact with someone diagnosed with measles
- you've been in close contact with someone who has measles and you're pregnant or have a weakened immune system Attend Accident and Emergency/call 999 for support if:
- child has a seizure
- child is limp/floppy/unresponsive and/or has difficulty breathing
- child is unable to stay awake, is confused/behaving strangely/inconsolably crying
- there is a rash that does not disappear when a glass is pressed against it
- neck stiffness/pain
