Attendance

While attendance has been excellent so far this term, I have included the following information (which I first sent in the summer term) as a reminder about the new penalty notice fines for non-attendance.

From the 19th August, the government has issued new penalty notice fines for school attendance. The fines, for more than 10 sessions (5 days) taken out of school in a 10 week period, begin at £160 per parent per child (it is reduced if you pay within 21 days) for a first offence to the penalty being sent straight to court and being fined up to £2,500 per parent per child for repeat offences.
